12am-5am: Annas and Caiaphas

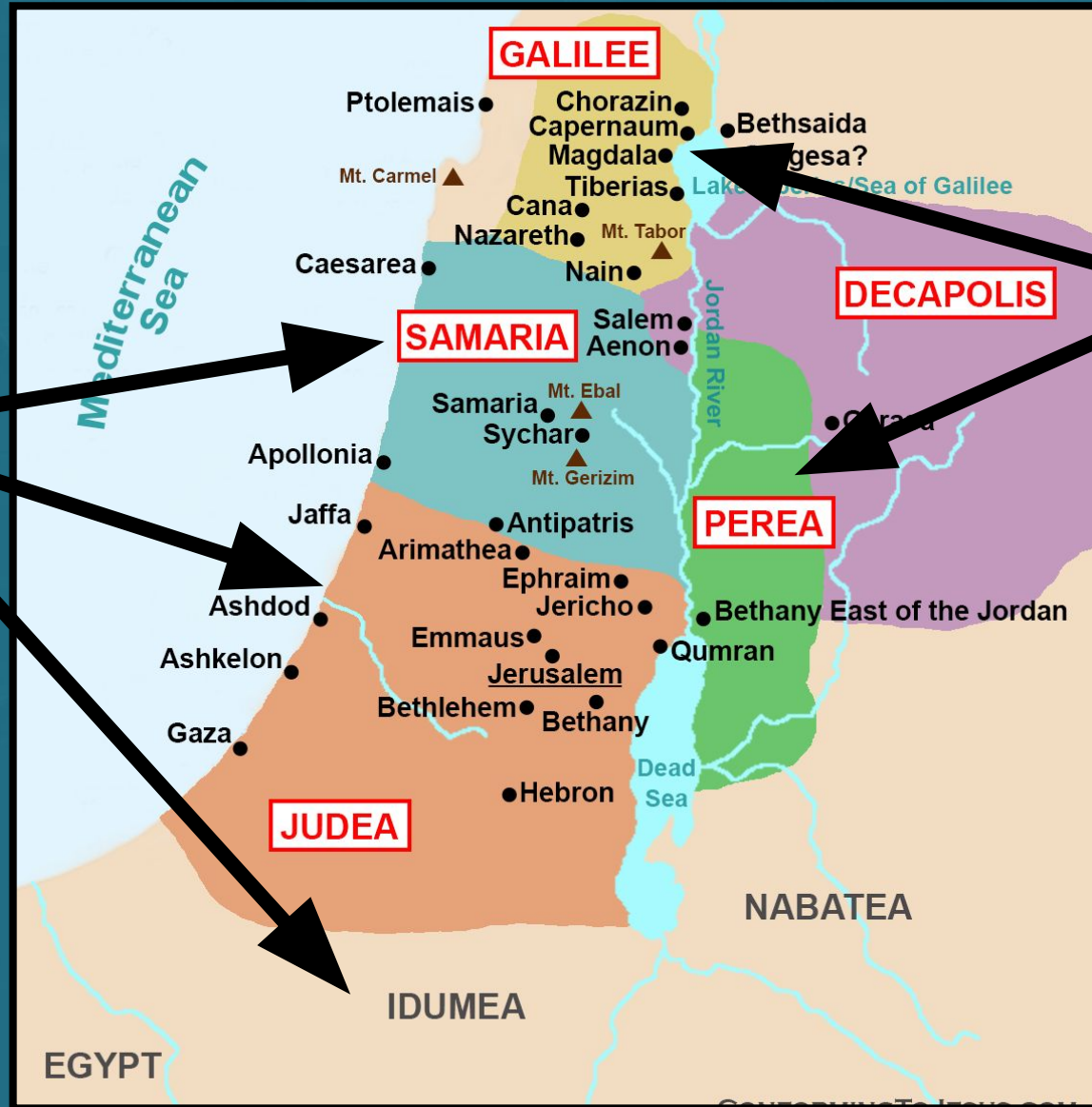
5am-6am: formal Sanhedrin verdict

Luke 23:23 (ESV)

But they were urgent, demanding with loud cries that Jesus should be crucified.
And their voices prevailed.

The road to Golgotha

Forgiveness: “Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.” (Luke 23:34)

Salvation: “Truly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in paradise.” (Luke 23:43)

Compassion: “Woman, behold your son...
Behold your mother.” (John 19:26-27)


Suffering: “My God, my God, why have You
forsaken Me?” (Matthew 27:46; Mark 15:34)

Humanity: “I thirst.” (John 19:28)

Victory: “It is finished.” (John 19:30)

Trust: “Father, into Your hands I commit
My spirit.” (Luke 23:46)
