In John 17 Jesus prayed:

- for our **SPIRITUAL PROTECTION**
- for our **SPIRITUAL GROWTH**
- that we would **EXPERIENCE GOD'S LOVE**

²³ I in them and You in Me, that they may become perfectly one, so **that the world may know** that You sent Me and **loved them even as you loved Me.**

John 17:23-26

24 Father, I desire that they also, whom You have given Me, may be with Me where I am, to see My glory that You have given Me because You loved Me before the foundation of the world.

²⁵ O righteous Father, even though the world does not know You, I know You, and these know that You have sent Me.

²⁶ I made known to them Your name, and I will continue to make it known that **the love with which You have loved me may be in them**, and I in them.
