















The Period of the Judges (1400 – 1050 BC)

The 12 Tribes of Israel




NORTHERN KINGDOM (ISRAEL)


- 19 kings all bad
- After 209 years of rebellion and God sending prophet after prophet – Israel was exiled into Assyria in 722 BC.

SOUTHERN KINGDOM (JUDAH)

- 20 kings 12 bad, 8 good
- After 345 years of one-and-off rebellion – and God sending prophet after prophet – Jerusalem was destroyed and the people were exiled to Babylon in 586 BC
