1. to forgive our sins (Ephesians 1:7)
2. to give us eternal life in heaven (John 3:16)

Why did Jesus die and rise again?

3. to reconcile us to God (Romans 5:10)
4. to justify us (Romans 3:23-24; 2 Cor. 5:21)
5. to make us holy (Hebrews 10:10)
6. to make us into a new creation (2 Cor. 5:17)

Why did Jesus die and rise again?

7. to raise us to spiritual life (Eph. 2:4-6)
8. to save us from God's wrath (Romans 5:9)
9. to adopt us into God's family (Eph. 1:5)
10. so we would live righteously (1 Peter 2:24)

Why did Jesus die and rise again?

11. to free us from fear of death (Heb. 2:14-15)
12. to defeat the devil (1 John 3:8)
13. to reconcile all things to God (Col. 1:19–20)
14. so we could praise God (1 Peter 2:9)

15. so we would live an outward-focused life!

2 Corinthians 5:15

And Jesus died for all, that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for Him who for their sake died and was raised.

Ephesians 2:10

For we are Christ's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

Titus 2:14

Jesus gave Himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession who are **zealous for good works**.



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
