- 1. Read Matthew 7:24-28. Jesus ended the Sermon on the Mount by telling the parable of a wise and foolish builder. He compared implementing His teaching to creating a solid foundation in your life. Discuss a time in your life when you relied on a specific passage to guide you.
- 2. Read Proverbs 13:20. Discuss someone who has had a major impact on your faith. Why do you think it is important to find people who can positively influence you spiritually?
- 3. What are some practical steps you can take to have a positive impact on someone else's faith?
- 4. Spiritual disciplines are something we all know we need to implement in our lives. Praying, reading scripture, fasting, and giving are just a few. What spiritual disciplines do you do really well and what area do you need to grow in? How can the group help you in the area you need to grow?
- 5. One of the best ways to grow spiritually is to use the gifts and talents that God has given you. What are some of the reasons people don't want to serve either by teaching a class, volunteering on Sunday morning or going on a mission trip?
- 6. What steps would you take to encourage someone you knew was capable of serving in an area but lacked the confidence?
- 7. Read James 1:2-4. What are some pivotal circumstances that have shaped your faith? A pivotal circumstance can either be a positive experience or a loss in your life. How can you support someone who is currently going through a trial?
