Are you interested in finding a way for your family to serve together that is kid-friendly and can work around your schedule? Dough 2 Door has a need which may work for your family! Please prayerfully consider if your family could cook food together which would be used to feed the homeless in Allentown on Saturdays. Families would be able to serve very well in Steps 1 & 2 of this ministry depending on your gifts and willingness.

1 - Prepare food - Cook food for 20-25 servings. Main entre, side dish, bread, dessert, all or any of these food items. Our goal is to serve a full balanced meal of Meat, vegetable, starch and dessert with a water bottle. We will provide the aluminum chafing dishes (you can pick a 1/2 pan or full pan and lids)We can also provide food ingredients from our food donors (Wegmans, Whole Foods, Giant, etc). The food can be made any day of the week and put in the Carlson freezer or set up so that someone picks it up to be heated on Saturday.

2 - Pack the food into packages on Saturday 2:30-:30pm -

Meet together to heat the prepared food and then dish them into a 3 compartment take out container. Wrap a fork and napkin and put both into a grocery bag. We supply all these materials, we need the helping hands. They go into warmer packing bags, to go out to Allentown at 3:30pm

3 - Serve outside in Allentown - We serve the food (in the packed grocery bags) at 2 locations 4PM - Jackson Park at 9th and Jackson Street, 4:30PM - 7th street west side behind the 7 Eleven on Linden Street. We serve until all the food is gone! The people in need are waiting for us and grateful for anything served. For most it's the only food they'll eat that day. We ask to serve with kindness and love.
