EPIC – THE LARGER STORY

1. Do you live like you are a part of a larger story?
2. How do you sometimes view life? Like it is random, drudgery, routine, pointless?
3. What larger story makes your heart come alive? What is holding you back from pursuing that story?

THE POSER

1. Until you see how you're posing and how you're living out a counterfeit masculinity, you'll never choose or pursue your true self. Ask yourself, how do you hide? How are you posing?

2. How is God disrupting your life to expose the poser?

3. What words would you use to describe yourself right now at this point in your life? Would you use words like courageous, strong, loving, passionate, dangerous or genuine?

4. What words would those who know you use to describe you? Do you have the courage to ask them what words they would use? What do you fear they would say?

HEALING THE WOUND

1. Every little boy needs to know that he is deeply and profoundly loved by his father. He needs to be delighted in and he needs validation. Every one of us was meant to hear from our father the answer to the question: Do I have what it takes? What did your earthly father communicate to you as a boy?
2. Bring your wounded heart to God and ask him: *Father do you love me? Am I your delight?* What do you hear him saying?
3. Have you ever asked Jesus to come and heal your wounded places as a man, to strengthen you, so that you can live as the man you want to be?
