1. COME WITH A **HUMBLE HEART** (1 COR. 11:3)

“But I want you to understand that the head of every man is Christ, the head of a wife is her husband, and the head of Christ is God.”

1 Corinthians 11:3

“When you come together, it is not the Lord’s supper that you eat. For in eating, each one goes ahead with his own meal. One goes hungry, another gets drunk...So then, my brothers, when you come together to eat, wait for one another.” **1 Corinthians 11:20-21, 33**
