1. THE MIRACLE (JOHN 6:1-10)

A miracle is something that happens that cannot be described by our natural laws, something only God can do.

You can approach miracles in one of three ways:

- 1) Reject them as altogether impossible
- 2) Remain open and curious and ask God to help you believe
- 3) Recognize God's power and authority to act outside the set of natural laws and order He created

No matter how much evidence we have of God's existence, we will ultimately still have to come to Him by FAITH

3 Things Typically True of Miracles:

- 1) They are a demonstration of God's power
- 2) They typically involve God's people in their accomplishment
- 3) They call on people to discover and believe a truth about who God is

The primary purpose of a miracle is to teach us something about God. The secondary purpose is the blessing.

2. THE METHOD (JOHN 6:11-13)

3 ways we can respond to a "God-sized" moment:

1) DISBELIEF (Philip)

How has your LOGIC made you forget Jesus' LORDSHIP?

2) DOUBT (Andrew)

How has your DOUBT discouraged other people?

3) FAITH (Little Boy)

How have your INSECURITIES kept you from obedience?

3. THE MEANING (JOHN 6:35-40)

Miracles AUTHENTICATE who Jesus is and build a BRIDGE to share the Gospel

"For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day." John 6:40

Everything without Jesus = NOTHING

Nothing with Jesus = EVERYTHING
