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
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It's called a Chiastic Structure



- Incline your ear, O LORD, and answer me, for I am poor and needy.
- 2, 3 ...
- Gladden the soul of your servant, for to you, O Lord, do I lift up my soul.
- ¹⁶ Turn to me and be gracious to me;
- Show me a sign of your favor, that those who hate me may see and be put to shame


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
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II. Our God of Steadfast Love-Who the psalmist's Father is

- For you, O Lord, are good and forgiving abounding in steadfast love to all who call upon you.
- But you, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness.





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III. The Psalmist's Trial or Issue

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- Give ear, O LORD, to my prayer; listen to my plea for grace.
- In the day of my trouble I call upon you, for you answer me.
- O God, insolent men have risen up against me; a band of ruthless men seeks my life, and they do not set you before them.

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IV. Our God's Power & Faithfulness



(Past / Future Performance)

- There is none like you among the gods, O Lord, ...
- 9 All the nations you have made shall come and worship before you, O Lord ...
- For you are great and do wondrous things; for you alone are God.
- ¹² I give thanks to you, O Lord my God, ... and I will glorify your name forever.
- For great is your steadfast love toward me; for you have delivered my soul from the depths of Sheol

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Teach me your way, O LORD, that I may walk in your truth; unite my heart to fear your name.

One Last Thing



As we look back from the summit – back to where the psalmist or we had asked for a sign in verse 17 – Well, we have a sign -

Romans 8:32 He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will He not also with Him (Jesus) graciously give us all things?
