Wise in the Meantiming

Passage: James 5:1-11 Pastor Eric Hoehn

Introduction:

Question: As we mark the days <u>WAITING</u> for Jesus, <u>HOW</u> do we "in the meantime" <u>WELL</u>?

Main Point: Wisdom tells us that if we desire to be <u>**GOOD**</u> "in the meantimers," we must <u>**USE THAT**</u> TIME as Jesus means us to.

Be a Wise "In the Meantimer"

Choice 1: We can use our "in the meantime" <u>**TO CREATE</u>** our own <u>**HEAVEN ON EARTH.**</u></u>

Choice 2: We can use our "in the meantime" to **<u>PREPARE</u>** for the <u>**NEW**</u> **<u>HEAVEN**</u> and the <u>**NEW**</u> **<u>EARTH**</u>.

Principle: We are wise "in the meantimers" when we live as if <u>WE</u> <u>BELIEVE</u> there is a <u>NEW WORLD COMING</u>.

Conclusion:
