Introduction

Principle: Godliness poisoned with **GREED** lines the road to an **EMPTY LIFE**.

Principle: We should **RELEASE** our **GRASP** on the American dream.

Point 2: The Good Life Can Only be Taken Hold of Through the Relentless Pursuit of the JESUS SHAPED LIFE.

Principle: Godliness supplemented with CONTENTMENT paves the road to the GOOD LIFE.
