Question

Main Point

If we want to avoid **COSTLY BREAKDOWNS** in the church and in our own lives, we should be faithful to perform good **PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE**.

Maintenance Tip 1: Work hard to keep things RUNNING RIGHT.

Remove the MUZZLES.

Maintenance Tip 2: Be quick to fix **SMALL THINGS** before they become **BIG THINGS**.

Beware **MECHANICAL** application.

Apply the **GALATIANS 6:1** principle.

Perform constant **SELF CHECKS**.

Use the right APPROACH.

Do I have all the **FACTS and NUANCES**?

Am I being **RESPECTFUL**?

Am I being **GENTLE**?

Am I being **PATIENT**?

Am I prepared to join their **JOURNEY**?
