
Bible Discussion Notes THE GREAT ESCAPE

How do you think Hannah felt not having children?



What did the brothers plan to do to Joseph?



Who was Deborah and why was she important?



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

Word Battle

Get some scrabble tiles/letter tiles and select 12 letters. Give the group 60 seconds to find as many different words as they can. Whoever gets the most words wins. If you don't have access to any letter tiles, you can use the letters we used in our episode.




David and Goliath Battleships

This game is super easy and fun to play. Just like the classic game battleships, this game requires a grid to play. To make it simple, you can use a 3x3 grid just like tic-tac-toe. We have provided one for you to print off, or you can make/draw your own.

Then you'll need to keep track of you and your opponents guesses. We have provided some pebbles to cut out which you will 'throw' at your opponents 'giant', which is the helmet cut-out.


To play, each player places their giant on their bottom grid. Then take it in turns to guess where your opponents giant is by calling out a grid reference and place a pebble in the corresponding square if it is a miss. You can do the same for your opponents guesses on your grid to track how close they are getting! The winner will be the first to hit the other person's giant.




