What is a Parable?

- ♦ Any type of saying or story that contains a comparison or a parallel.
- "parable" means " a comparing together" or "laying one thing aside another".
- Something physical alongside something spiritual.
- Earthly story with heavenly meaning. 1/3 of Jesus's teachings are in story form.

Key Elements

- \diamond Seed: Word of God.
- ♦ Sower: one who throws the seed.
- ♦ Soil: heart that receives "truth".

Four Kinds of hearts

- ♦ Hard hearts Matthew 13:4
- ♦ Shallow hearts Mathew 13:5 & 20, Luke 8:13
- ♦ Unfruitful hearts Matthew 13:7
- ♦ Receptive hearts Matthew 13:8, Matthew 13:23

Luke 8:18

- ◊ "take heed how you hear
- ♦ Hearing truth can be dangerous (Matthew 7:24-27)
- ♦ God's judgement is according to truth.
- Many hear the truth but fail to respond. Listen & apply!
