# Jesus Humbled Himself, to the Father's will.

#### In Birth

- Philippians 2:6 "Being in the form of God"
- Jesus Christ always has been and continues presently to be God.
- ♦ Jesus was God pre-human, that was His essential form.
- He emptied Himself not of being God... but of:

i. the privilege or prerogatives of His deity. (John 17:5)

ii. independent authority... Jesus voluntarily surrendered, submitted, to the will of the

Father in Heaven. (John 5:30).

# In Life

- Phillipians 2:7 "Taking the form of a bondservant"
- Jesus Christ the God-man. Both natures; divine and human

## In Death

- ♦ Philippians 2:8 "Even the death of the cross"
- His death was the epicenter of redemptive history.
- Jesus Christ took on Himself, our sins and trespasses upon the cross.

- ♦ Philippians 2:9-11 The Son's Reward
- Jesus is exalted, above all others and given all authority, power and glory.
