The crucifixion of Christ is the climax of redemptive history.

The cross of Christ demonstrates the "grace", the "mercy", the "goodness", the "kindness", the "justice" and the 'love" of God.

Hope is Alive because Christ died for our sins.

 Died for sins once – Greek. Hapax: means one time only, does not require repeating.

Hope is Alive because Jesus became our substitute.

- Substitution... our sins imputed to Him and His righteousness then credited to us.
