The Crowd (Matthew 7:21-23)

- ♦ Mix of supporters and cynics
- ♦ Want something from Jesus
- ♦ Tend to be inconstant and fickle
- Close to Jesus in proximity, but far relationally.

God gives us richly all things to enjoy

- Not possessions, but attitude towards them.
- Wealth and possessions (material) are for this life only, therefore no lasting value (eternal)
- ♦ Seek God's kingdom and these things will be given to you as well. (v. 31)
- ◊ God is pleased to give you the kingdom. (v. 32)

- ◊ Jesus is more important than anything else in life (Matthew 19:27)
- ♦ Loves Jesus in every way (Matthew 22:37)
- ♦ Applies all the words of Jesus in all areas of life (John 14:15; John 8:31-32)
- Stands out from the crowd (Matthew 5:16)
- Has divine revelation of who Jesus is (Matthew 16:16-17)
- ♦ The centre of God's affection (John 3:16)
- ♦ Relationally close to Jesus (15:15)
