- Matthew 20:30-34
- 5 verbs
 - He **heard**,
 - He **stopped**,
 - He **looked**,
 - He asked and
 - He touched.

Listen for clues that people are in pain.

- Love starts with listening.
- People all around us are in pain but we don't see them or hear them.
- They are marginalized.
 - Job 19:7
 - Matthew 20:32 "...Jesus heard them."
 - Psalm 18:6

Stop whatever you're doing.

- If we are going to show love, we must get used to being interrupted.
- Showing love does not come in the scheduled things in life, but in the interruptions.
- The number one hindrance of showing love is business.

Look, look beyond their behaviour.

- Mark 10:21
- The Lord looked with eyes of unconditional love and acceptance.
- Matthew 9:36
- Jesus looked at people and saw their need, He saw their pain, He saw their hurt.

Look, look beyond their behaviour.

- We can't look out for people if we are looking down on people.
- We must look past people's behaviour and see their value.

Ask people what they need

- O How can I help you?

Do whatever you can to help
