God How did Israel get here?

- ♦ Exodus 14:1-2
- ♦ Exodus 13: 18
- God purposely lead them to this place.

Trust Wherever He Leads.

- When God leads us to a dead end, it is to teach to trust Him for the way out.
- Just because you may have your back against the wall, does not mean you are out of the will of God.
- God cannot lead you to cross the Red Sea, until God leads you to come to the Red Sea.

Obey God.

- ♦ "Be Still"
- ♦ Psalm 46:10
- You trust wherever God leads, then you obey God whenever He speaks.

Glorify God Whatever He Does.

- Everything that God does for us is not just for His glory, it is by His grace.
- ♦ Remember God's promise.

- 1. The parting of the Red Sea was a significant moment in Israel's history. Even today, we may face "Red Sea Moments." (Red Sea Moment: no way out, everything points to failure and defeat-if you live long enough, you'll have a moment like this.) Have you gone through a Red Sea Moment? Are you going through one now? Share your experience of how critical it was to rely on God.
- 2. Read Exodus 14:16. Discuss: God's simple instruction to Moses as he faced the sea; What Moses must have felt in this moment; What he had to do before he saw the sea parted.
- 3. Pastor Bob mentioned we must Trust where God leads". How do you respond to someone who questions: How do I trust a God I cannot see? Share a Scripture you rely on or go to when you face difficulty situations.
- 4. Read Exodus 14. What is your response to what is happening? What key words can you highlight from the text?
