Exodus 20 - The 10 Commands

First Command | Exodus 20:2-3

- ♦ All other gods are frauds and fakes.
- ♦ There are no other real gods
- ♦ Psalm 115:4-8

Second command | Exodus 20:4-6

- ♦ The 1st worship God only.
- ♦ The 2nd how to worship God.
- There are no images of God, you could ever cast, paint or make that will capture all who He is.

Third Commandment | Exodus 20:7

"in vain" means to "empty something of it's content, or its "value".



Forth Commandment | Exodus 20:8

♦ Sabbath – Shabbat means to cease, to rest



Fifth Commandment | Exodus 20:12

♦ Obedience (1 Peter 2:9)

Sixth Commandment | Exodus 20:13

Seventh Commandment | Exodus 20:14

 Sex is God given, it must be God governed, God directed, God guided

Eighth Commandment | Exodus 20:15

♦ Malachi 3:8

Ninth Commandment | Exodus 20:16

♦ Based on the character of God. God loves truth and hates falsehood.

Tenth Commandment | Exodus 20:17

 - b. Read Matthew 22:34-40. How does Jesus' statement impact the way we view the commandments?
 - c. What are some practical ways married couples can protect their marriage from an adulterous relationship? (Hebrews 13:4).
