#### The Law & the Tabernacle

- ◇ The Law Exodus 20-24
- ♦ The Tabernacle Exodus 25-31
- ◊ The law will facilitate people's obedience to God
- ◊ The tabernacle will facilitate their worship to God.

### Two central expressions of faith; obedience and worship.

#### Metaphor – "I bore you on eagles' wings"

- ♦ The eagle builds its nest in inaccessible places.
- Baby eagles are completely dependant on their mother.
- ♦ God took Israel to an inaccessible place.
- ♦ Eagles are very protective of their own.
- God brings Israel out to the desert to an inaccessible place to bring them to maturity.
