GROW | Dive Deeper

- 1. Read Luke 16:10-11 together. Discuss some ways we show unfaithfulness in the area of finances?
- 2. "It is not the amount, but being faithful with the little." Discus the relevance of this statement in your life.
- Pastor Bob asked the question: What would cause God to bless us? The answer:
 Obedience and Faithfulness. Draw on some Biblical references or examples that demonstrate this principle.
- 4. Read the story of Zacchaeus in Luke 19:1-10, and the story of the Rich Young Ruler in Matthew 19:16-22.
 - a. Contrast their encounter with Jesus.
 - b. What can we learn from their responses after an encounter with Jesus?
- 5. In Mark 12:41, "Jesus sat down opposite the place where the offerings were put and watched the crowd putting their money into the temple treasury."
 - a. What do you think about Jesus positioning himself near the treasury to watch...?
 - b. If we know God is watching, how should this affect the way we use our resources, possessions, gifts, and finances?

GO | Apply

Personal Reflection: If your money could talk what would it say about you, the spender? Pray and ask God to help you become a good steward of your finances/resources.

Commit yourself this week to fast in the area where you are overspending and give instead to the work of God (offerings, missions, sponsor a child, another charity etc.)

Perhaps you need to work on a budget and be a better steward of God's money. Find a budget that works for you and implement it this week.
