### **Small Group Questions**

#### Connection

Many children are asked what they want to be when they grow up. Could you tell us what you wanted to be as a child? Did that dream become a reality in your career as an adult?

- 1. How does one go about identifying their plows?
- 2. Pastor Ben said we need to break the pattern that keeps us bound but we cannot destroy what we cannot define. Can you reflect on and share with us the things that kept/keep you from going after that dream?
- 3. Find the definition of a stronghold: What does Paul say about fortresses and walls we believe about ourselves? (2 Corinthians 10:4-5)
- 4. Has God impressed a word on your heart for this season?
- 5. Can you recall when God said "no", "wait", "go" or "stay"?
  a. What does waiting on the Lord mean? Read Psalm 62:5-7.
  b. When you think of the word wait in connection to your relationship with God, what comes to mind?

### GO

- 1. Spend some quality time with the Lord this week to have the Holy Spirit assist you in selfidentifying plows (strongholds), in your life that you need to burn.
  - Read and declare scriptures about who you are in Christ. (2 Corinthians 5:17, Galatians
     3:26, Romans 6:6, Colossians 3:12, 1 Peter 4:10, 1 John 2:13, Romans 8:37, Jeremiah 29:11).
- 2. Resolve in your heart to get back on track and PUSH (pray until something happens)
