The Title

- ◇ “revelation” means “unveiling”, “to uncover”, “to reveal”

The Purpose of the Book

- ◇ Primarily the revelation of Jesus Christ.
- ◇ Jesus is the chief subject of the book.
- ◇ Revelation 1:1
- ◇ “and to show God’s servants the future.”
- ◇ ‘things’ which must shortly take place.
- ◇ ‘must’...will surely happen
- ◇ ‘shortly’ ...quickly, suddenly and rapidly.
- ◇ ‘signified’ ...the letter is full of signs and symbols.

The Blessing

- ◇ The joy of knowing in the end Jesus wins and satan loses.
- ◇ Who is the book written to? It was written to the seven churches (to them) and it was written for us.
- ◇ These churches were facing 30 years of severe persecution.
- ◇ The churches were encouraged – don’t give up, shine in the darkness.

The Theme

- ◇ Revelation 1:4-8
- ◇ The return of Jesus to defeat all evil and establish His reign.
- ◇ A book of victory.
