 - c. Jericho- a place of past victories, looking back
 - d. Jordan crossing over, dying to self and living for Christ
- 2. Was Elijah's instruction to Elisha a command from God or just a request? How do you know? What does the context tell us about why Elisha refused?
- 3. Explain Elisha's request that is, what did he mean by a double portion?
- 4. In what ways have you experienced disappointments, delays, and seemingly unanswered prayers which God used for your good? How can we maintain and increase our faith in the midst of what seems like a disappointment?
- 5. What daring requests have you asked the Lord for in the past and what was the outcome? What daring requests do you believe God is calling you to pray for yourself and others (including your family, church, and nation) in this season?
