Three calls for every believer.

Kaleo – To call (Root of 16 other very important words in the New Testament)

- ♦ Klesis—Calling
- ♦ Kletos—Called
- Paraklete—Comforter (A picture of the Holy Spirit.)
- Parakletos—Advocate, Intercessor (Another picture of the Holy Spirit.)
- ♦ Ekklesia—Called out ones The Church

You're Called to Sanctification

- Calling is about who you are before what you do.
- Jesus said, "Whoever wants to be a leader among you must be your servant" (Mark 10:43, NLT).
- The size of your assignment never determines the significance of your impact.
 - When everything you do, you do for the glory of God.
 - You don't have to find your calling, your calling will find you.

- ♦ The priority is people.
- ♦ The moment you step into your calling, you have to step out of your comfort.
