# Share Hope

- If someone asks about your Christian hope, always be ready to explain it. 1 Peter 3:15 NLT
- We should be ready to give the reason for our hope.
- In Luke 10 there are principles we can learn that still apply to why, where, and how we share hope.

# I. Why to Share Hope

- Luke 10:1-2 (NASB) 1 Now after this the Lord appointed seventy others, and sent them in pairs ahead of Him to every city and place where He Himself was going to come. 2 And He was saying to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.
- What Jesus says to them demonstrates their why, and it continues to be our why...
- The Harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few.

# I. Why to Share Hope

- In the physical, we do more harvesting with less labourers than the less developed world.
- In the spiritual, we are relying on our machinery, and not on the labourers.
- We are relying on money, tools, equipment, and information to Harvest, but what we need is praying labourers.

#### I. Why to Share Hope

- There are people looking for hope.
- We are instructed to pray as we go.
- This Easter we have a desire that everyone will bring at least one guest to church.
- Without prayer and all of our involvement, things will stay the same.

# II. Where to Share Hope

- Matthew 28:19 (NASB) "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit,
  - As you go, make disciples.
  - As you transfer through life.
  - As you continue on your journey.
- Evangelism should be apart of our regular life.

# II. Where to Share Hope

- It is not about geography, it is about proximity.
- Jesus will direct you.
- God had a purpose for planting us in a particular place.
- Jesus knows where he wants to go and he goes there through you.
- He sent them in pairs ahead of Him to every city and place where He Himself was going to come.

# II. Where to Share Hope

- This partnership is two ways; where you go, He will follow.
- When Jesus shows up things can shift.
- There is a lot we can do to share hope where God has placed us.

- When sharing hope both boldness and shyness have drawbacks.
- The bold need to be aware of their approach.
- The shy need to be confident in their ability.
- Luke 10:3-4 3 "Go; behold, I send you out as lambs in the midst of wolves. 4 "Carry no money belt, no bag, no shoes; and greet no one on the way.

- When we share hope we should not overwhelm or over plan.
- We are lambs, not wolves
- We all like sheep have gone astray, turned to our own way, but God...
- Jesus instructs us to go as lambs.


- There are lots of other lambs who have lost their way and need a "but God moment"...
- We are a family that shares the good news of Jesus Christ.
- We are a family that Shows Love,
- We are a family that Shares Hope
- We are a family that Shares Faith

- Shy people don't need to become bold to share hope.
- There is a lot we can do to share hope where God has placed us.
- Jesus instructs them to take no money, no bag, and no shoes. He also tells them not to greet people on the way.

- Actions speak louder than words, but words whisper truth.
- Actions gets a person's attention, but words win their heart.
- Love can be shown in actions, but Hope needs to be spoken.

#### **Speak Blessing**

- Often people cannot hear the word concerning Christ because something else is in the way.
- We often speak apathetically, or critically when we are called to speak prophetically.

#### **Speak Blessing**

Numbers 6:22-27 (NASB) 22 Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, 23 "Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, 'Thus you shall bless the sons of Israel. You shall say to them: 24 The LORD bless you, and keep you; 25 The LORD make His face shine on you, And be gracious to you; 26 The LORD lift up His countenance on you, And give you peace.' 27 "So they shall invoke My name on the sons of Israel, and I then will bless them."

#### **Speak Blessing**

 The words we speak are powerful whether or not we are speaking the right ones.

James 3:7-10 (NLT) 7 People can tame all kinds of animals, birds, reptiles, and fish, 8 but no one can tame the tongue. It is restless and evil, full of deadly poison. 9 Sometimes it praises our Lord and Father, and sometimes it curses those who have been made in the image of God. 10 And so blessing and cursing come pouring out of the same mouth. Surely, my brothers and sisters, this is not right!

#### **Speak Blessing**

- Ed Silvoso, Transformational Leader
- **Reason #1:** We need to declare peace because we, as Christians, have been at war with the lost.
- Reason #2: If we bless the lost, we will stop cursing them.
- Reason #3: We speak peace in order to neutralize the spiritual forces that have been assigned to blind our neighbors to the light of the gospel.

#### **Speak Blessing**

Acts 26: 17,18,(NIV) I am sending you to them to open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God.

- Speaking blessing over people is the first step to prayer evangelism.
- Simply put, prayer evangelism is talking to God about our neighbors before we talk to our neighbors about God.

#### **E**at Food

- Much of Jesus ministry centered around food.
- People connect over good food.
- So whether in homes or cafes let's use food to connect.

#### Pray for Needs

#### **Tell the Good News**

- 1 Peter 3:13-17 (NLT) 13 Now, who will want to harm you if you are eager to do good? 14 But even if you suffer for doing what is right, God will reward you for it. So don't worry or be afraid of their threats.
- 15 Instead, you must worship Christ as Lord of your life. If someone asks about your Christian hope, always be ready to explain it.

#### **Tell the Good News**

1 Peter 3:13-17 (NLT) 16 But do this in a gentle and respectful way. Keep your conscience clear. Then if people speak against you, they will be ashamed when they see what a good life you live because you belong to Christ. 17 Remember, it is better to suffer for doing good, if that is what God wants, than to suffer for doing wrong!
