Getting Started

What gifts have you used to serve others? Do you see your gifts as something to bless you or others or both?

Discussion

What stood out to you from this past weekend's sermon?

Why does Peter emphasize the importance of love in context with the end of all things?

What connections do you see between the Gospel and the directives to love and serve each other?

In vs. 8 he says, "...love covers a multitude of sins." What does that mean to you and how have you seen that fulfilled in your life?

Peter seems to correlate the gifts mentioned with the "how-to" and the purpose (vs. 8-11). What are those and why is it important to you and your group?

Prayer

Pray for any needs anyone has and share any ways that God has shown up in your life.

Pray for clarity of giftings for each person in your group. Consider taking a few moments to have others in the group speak to gifts they see in each person. Make sure each person has received the affirmations from the group. Ask the Spirit of God to lead you into a practical application of what has been shared.

As you go

Read various passages regarding specific spiritual gifts and categories of gifts and pray how God might reveal and multiply his purposes in your life. (Romans 12, I Corinthians 12:1-11, Ephesians 4:4-16, etc.) As he reveals a message for you, take a direct action step to implementing what that is. Share it with your group next week.
