Why is understanding your identity so important, especially in our world today?

Discussion

What stood out from this past weekend's sermon?

Why do you think Peter refers to Jesus as the living Stone, and the church as living stones? How do you picture these images working together?

Peter builds on the theme by referring to Jesus as a cornerstone and as a capstone. What is similar and what is different in these? Why does it matter?

Peter lists four new identities for people of faith (vs.9). What are they? How would knowing these truths help this persecuted church? How does knowing these truths help you today?

In light of these verses, what does it mean to you to be part of the family of God? Do you believe you are precious to Him? Why or why not?

As you go

You are God's special possession in Christ. Do you know it? Spend time reading 1 Peter 2:9-10 this week and commit these verses to memory so you don't ever forget your new identity.
