Getting Started

What is the most important question you have ever been asked or asked another person?

Discussion

What do you remember from the sermon that you would like to discuss further?

Look back through the list of people mentioned when Jesus asks, “Who do you say I am?”. What do they have in common? What about differences? What do you think the answers would be today?

Why does Jesus ask his students who everyone else thinks he is before he asks who they think he is?

Why does Jesus ask them who they say he is? Try to rephrase Jesus’ question, “Who do you say I am?” in your own words.

Jesus is...Savior, Judge, Lord, Bridegroom, Returning King, God...which of these do you identify with most? How about least? Why?

As you go

As you look at the list of who Jesus is and come to grips with the one that is the most difficult for you to swallow or identify with, plan this week to address Jesus in prayer as such (eg. King Jesus, Savior Jesus, Returning King Jesus, etc.).

Prayer

Who has a need they would like the Group to pray for? How about a story from this past week of victory and praise?

Spend time praising Jesus for who he is. Sing a worship song together, pray through the list of who Jesus is from the last question. Praise Jesus in prayer!
