- Read Hebrews 13:16.
  - How does this help our churches keep Jesus in charge?
  - What are some ways our church is doing this together?
    - And can do this together?
- Read Hebrews 13:17.
  - How does this help our churches keep Jesus in charge?
  - What does it mean to "obey and submit"?
  - Under what circumstances should we not do this?
  - Why do we want the job of elder to be "with joy"?
    - How can we make this happen?
