 - How does the devil try to keep us apart when we don't have to be?
- Read Ephesians 2:13-16
 - How did Jesus destroy the walls of division in His flesh?
 - How does this apply to us?
- Read Galatians 5:19-21
 - Why is "division" listed with sins like sorcery and orgies?
- Read Titus 3:10
 - Why is Paul so strong about this?
 - How is this different from being divisive?
