Sermon: Loving Justice

Primary Text: Revelation 19:1-5

Discussion guide:

- What is an example you can think of well delivered justice?
- What is an example of injustice?
- What is justice?
- Read Deuteronomy 32:4, Psalms 89:14, and Isaiah 61:8 – what does these tell us about God?
 - Based on these passages and Genesis 1:26-27 what does this tell us about ourselves? Why do we desire justice?
- Read Revelation 6:9-10, Revelation 18:20, and Revelation 19:1-5
 - How does Revelation 19:1-5 fulfill the first two passages?
- Why should we pray for justice?
 - What is the difference between justice and vengeance? (read Romans 12:19)
- Why/how should we fight for justice? (see Micah 6:8; Isaiah 1:17; Amos 5:24; Proverbs 31:8-9)
 - What is the difference between justice and forgiveness?
- What relationship does the fear of the Lord have with hating evil? (read Revelation 19:4-5, Proverbs 3:7, 8:13, & 16:6)
 - Read Psalms 73 – what caused Asaph to struggle? What was the solution?
 - What should we do when injustice discourages us?
