Sermon: Worshiping God

Primary Text: 2 Samuel 6:12b-23

Discussion guide:

 - What do you notice?

 - Do you worship with all your might?
- Worship is a celebration of God’s presence.
 - Why was God’s presence worth celebrating in the text?
 - Why is God’s presence worth celebrating today?
- Worship is a reaction to God’s glory.
 - What causes you to be in awe of God?
 - Why is being in awe of God comforting to us?
 - What can we do to be in awe of Him more?
- Worship is a submission to God’s authority.
 - How is worship submitting to God?
 - Why is this also joyous?
- What was Michal’s problem with David?
- What was David’s response?
 - What does he mean by “it was before the Lord”?
 - Who is our primary audience in worship?
- When should we worship?
- List the ways David and Israel worship in the text.
 - What are some ways we can worship now?
