 - O What does it mean to bless someone?
 - O What does this tell us we should do for our kids?
 - O What should we pray for our kids for?
- Read Hebrews 11:22
 - o How was Joseph displaying faith here?
 - What does this tell Christians parents they can do to foster such faith in their kids?
 - How can help our kids look to eternity?
- Read Hebrews 11:23
 - o How did Moses' parents display faith?
 - O How is what they did similar to what parents must do today?
 - o How can we prepare our kids to go out in the world?
