**Discussion Guide:**

- How would you define “ungodliness”?
- Bridges defines it as “living one’s everyday life with little or no thought of God, or of God’s will, or of God’s glory, or of one’s dependence on God.”
  - What jumps out at you about this?
- Read 1 Corinthians 10:31.
  - Explain what this verse means and how we can apply it to our lives.
- Read 1 Thessalonians 5:17.
  - Explain what this verse means and how we can apply it to our lives.
- How would you define selfishness?
- How would you define worldliness?
- Read 1 Timothy 4:7-8
  - How is living selfishly or in worldliness like living in a myth?
  - How would you define godliness?
  - Bridges defines it as “Our goal in the pursuit of godliness should be to grow more in our conscious awareness that every moment of our lives is lived in the presence of God; that we are responsible to Him and dependent on Him.”
    - What jumps out at you about this definition?
  - How is striving for godliness make our lives better now and after we pass from this life?
