## In Relation to God Exodus 19-20:11

If you trust me enough to follow me, you will become close to me, and my vessel to the world.

Command #1: "You shall have no other gods <u>before</u> me." "...to be fully <u>available</u> right where we were."

Command #2: You shall not <u>worship</u> any man-made "gods". "You are willing to <u>kill</u> something in your life for the object of your <u>worship</u>."

Commandment #3: "You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in <u>vain</u>." <u>only</u> use His name if you are talking <u>to</u> Him or <u>about</u> Him.

Commandment #4: "Remember the <u>Sabbath</u> day, to keep it holy." We <u>honor</u> God when we <u>rest</u>.

In conclusion: Obedience and appreciation.
