- Read Hebrews 10:23
 - What is love and good works?
 - How can these help us to hold fast to Christ?
 - Why is the word “consider” important?
 - How can we “stir up” others toward love and good works?
- Read Hebrews 10:25
 - Why is meeting together a habit?
 - Why is it easy to fall out of?
 - Why is this so essential?
