- Why doesn't faith need to see results?
- What does knowing you belong to another country have to do with not needing to see results in this life?
- Why doesn't faith need to understand all the details?
- What does it mean to reason by God's promises?
- Why do you think God asked Abraham to sacrifice his son?
 - o Was Isaac ever in danger?
 - O How was this good for Abraham and Isaac?
 - o How is this a foreshadowing of the Gospel?
