- Hell is God's <u>respect</u> for mankind's <u>choice</u>: "[Hell is the] greatest <u>monument</u> to human <u>freedom...</u>" C.S. Lewis
- Hell is <u>everlasting self-centeredness</u>: "Hell, then, is the <u>trajectory</u> of a soul, living a selfabsorbed, self-centered life, going on and on <u>forever</u>." – Timothy Keller
- Hell is God's <u>prerogative</u>: "God <u>alone</u> gets to decide how He is going to <u>deal</u> with people." Francis Chan
