- Hell is God's respect for mankind's choice: "[Hell is the] greatest monument to human freedom..." - C.S. Lewis
- Hell is everlasting self-centeredness: "Hell, then, is the trajectory of a soul, living a self-absorbed, self-centered life, going on and on forever." – Timothy Keller
- Hell is God's prerogative: "God alone gets to decide how He is going to deal with people." – Francis Chan
