Primary Texts: Psalms 8:3-8; Matthew 9:35-38

Discussion guide:

- Who in your life took responsibility to teach you things? To guide you through life? faith?
- Who in your life do you try to teach and guide in life? faith?
- Read Matthew 9:35-38
 - Why did Jesus feel compassion for them?
 - What did He do as a result of that?
 - What is He calling us to do?
- Read Psalms 8:3-8
 - What does this tell you about humanity?
- What are some common characteristics that seem to be less than what God wants for us and why would you categorize them thus? (i.e. anxiety, grudges, etc.)
- Read 1 Thessalonians 3:10
 - What does it mean to “supply what is lacking in your faith”?
 - How does Jesus do this for the woman at the well in John 4? The lepers in Matthew 8? Any time He taught the disciples? Any time He admonished the Pharisees?
- How can we become familiar with human potential?
 - How does becoming familiar with Jesus help us do this?
- How do we fight for other people’s walk with God?
 - How/why might our ways of helping change from person to person?
 - Why is remembering that we are not the solution but a part of the plan so important? (see 1 Corinthians 3:6-7)
- How do we seek and allow others to supply what is lacking in our faith?
 - Why is this essential to helping supply what is lacking for other’s faith?
 - Why is it easy to become defensive when people do this?
 - Why should we try hard to avoid feeling defensive?
