- Read Revelation 17:1-3
 - Why do you think Jesus presents Rome to the Christians in Asia minor as a prostitute here?
 - How does a person become "drunk" on sexual immorality?
 - How does a society do the same?
- Read Revelation 17:6
 - O Why does the prostitute have a cup of the blood of the saints?
 - o How is this always meaningful to what sexual immorality does to Christianity?
- Read Revelation 17:6 & 8
 - O Why do you think John "marveled" at the prostitute?
 - What does the warning seem to be here?
- Read Revelation 17:15-16
 - O What does this tell you about where sexual immorality will ultimately lead?
- Read 1 Corinthians 6:18
 - O What do you think Paul means by this?
 - O Why does he command us to flee from sexual immorality?
