Discussion guide:

- What comes to mind when the transgender debate comes up?
- What is gender dysphoria? What would it be like to feel this way?
- Do you know anyone who struggles with this?
- Why do you think it is such a prevalent issue today?
- What is a worldview?
 - Andrew Walker says that we look for a source to determine our world view with the authority to tell us what to do, the knowledge to know what is best for us, and the trustworthiness to want what is best for us.
- Why do we think God has the authority to tell us what to do?
- Why do we think God has the knowledge to know what is best for us?
- Why do we think God is trustworthy to know what is best for us?
- Who does the world say should be our source for our worldview?
- Why do many believe that self has the authority, knowledge and trustworthiness?
- Read Jeremiah 17:9 – Explain why you agree (or disagree) with the prophets warning about our hearts?
 - How is this different from what the world says?
- Read Matthew 19:4-6 – what does this tell you about God's attitude toward gender dysphoria?
- Why is it not only sinful but also, ultimately bad for a person to embrace transgenderism?
- How should Christians treat people who identify as transgender?
