

Series: Remembering Jesus, a study in Hebrews

Sermon: Jesus over Other Christians

Primary Text: Hebrews 3:1-6

Discussion guide:

- Share a/some Christians or Christian groups that have been instrumental in your walk with the Lord and how they influenced you? (authors, preachers, youth leaders, certain congregations or ministry groups)
- Have you ever had a Christian “hero” fall or let you down? How did that affect your faith?
- If a person walks away from the faith altogether when another Christian or Christians lets them down or falls into sin – were they putting their faith in Jesus in the first place?
- How/why do Christians often put more faith in other Christians than they do in Jesus?
- Read Hebrews 3:1-6
- What does it mean to consider Jesus?
 - How is He an apostle?
 - How is He a High priest?
- How important was Moses to the Jewish people?
- Why do you think the Hebrew writer is making a point that Jesus is superior to Moses?
- Why does the builder deserve more glory than the building?
 - See Romans 1:25
- Compare vs 5 and 6 discuss the significance of each of the following comparisons – speaking to why it meant then and how it should affect our thoughts about fellow Christians now.
 - “Moses *was* faithful...” vs “...but Christ *is* faithful...”
 - “Moses was faithful *in* all of God’s house...” vs “...but Christ is faithful *over* God’s house...”
 - “Moses was faithful in all of God’s house as a *servant*...” vs. “...but Christ is faithful over God’s house as a *Son*...”
- Read the last sentence of verse 6 – what is the condition placed on us to remain a part of His house?
