

**Series:** Remembering Jesus, a study in Hebrews

**Sermon:** Jesus over Angels

**Primary Text:** Hebrews 1

**Discussion guide:**

- Do you have a time when you forgot something that you can't believe you forgot? Share.
- In what ways do Christians often forget about Jesus?
  - Why is it so easy to forget about Him?
- Read Hebrews 2:1 – what is this saying? how does it help us?
- Read Hebrews 1:1-2
  - What does this tell you about Jesus?
    - Several theologians suggest that Hebrews is saying Jesus is “the last or final” word. How is this or how is this not true? (See John 1:1, 14, 17)
  - Verse 2 says that Jesus is the “heir of all things”.
    - What does this mean and why is it important for us to remember? (see Matthew 28:18, Philippians 2:10-11)
  - Verse 2 says that everything was created through Jesus.
    - What does this mean and why is it important for us to remember? (see John 1:3)
- Read Hebrews 1:3
  - It tells us that Jesus is the “radiance of God’s glory” and the “exact imprint” of God’s nature.
    - What does this mean and why is it important for us to remember? (John 1:18; John 17:25-26)
  - Verse 3 says that Jesus made “purification for sins”.
    - What does this mean and why is it important for us to remember? (See 2 Corinthians 5:21)
  - Verse 3 says that Jesus is sitting at the right hand of God.
    - What does this mean and why is it important for us to remember? (See Romans 8:34; Matthew 10:32-33)
- Read through each things Hebrews has told us about Jesus.
  - Were any of these new to you?
  - Were any particularly meaningful, encouraging, or convicting to you?
- Read Hebrews 2:1 – how does reviewing these things help us obey this text?
