Lev 23:5-6 “In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at twilight, is the Lord’s Passover. And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the Feast of Unleavened Bread to the Lord; for seven days you shall eat unleavened bread.”

Num 28:16 “On the fourteenth day of the first month is the Passover of the Lord.”

Num 9:5 “And they kept the Passover in the first month, on the **fourteenth day of the month, at twilight**, in the wilderness of Sinai; according to all that the Lord commanded Moses, so the people of Israel did.”

Matt 26:1-2 “When Jesus had finished all these sayings, he said to his disciples, **You know that after two days the Passover is coming**, and the Son of Man will be delivered up to be crucified.”

John 19:14-15 “Now it was the day of Preparation of the Passover. It was about the sixth hour. He said to the Jews, “Behold your King!” They cried out, “Away with him, away with him, crucify him!”

Gal 5:1-6 “For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery. 2 Look: I, Paul, say to you that if you accept circumcision, Christ will be of no advantage to you. 3 I testify again to every man who accepts circumcision that he is obligated to keep the whole law. 4 You are severed from Christ, you who would be justified by the law; you have fallen away from grace. 5 For through the Spirit, by faith, we ourselves eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness. 6 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only faith working through love.”

Ja 2:17 "Faith, if it has no works, is dead, being by itself."

1 Jhn 3:14 "We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we love the brethren. He who does not love abides in death."

1 Jhn 4:8 "The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love."

1 Jhn 4:16 "We have come to know and have believed the love which God has for us. God is love, and the one who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him."
