“Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!”

“The glory of God” is a way of saying that there is objective, absolute reality to which all human admiration, wonder, awe, veneration, praise, honor, acclaim, and worship is pointing. We were made to find our deepest pleasure in admiring what is infinitely admirable, that is, the glory of God. The glory of God is not the psychological projection of human longing onto reality. On the contrary, inconsolable human longing is the evidence that we were made for God’s glory.” **John Piper**

“Whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God” (1 Cor 10:31). All things were created for God’s glory (Is 43:6–7).

The great mission of the church is to declare God’s glory among the nations. “Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples!” (Ps 96:1–3; Ez 39:21; Is 66:18–19).

“We rejoice in hope of the glory of God” (Ro 5:2). God will “present you blameless before the presence of his glory with great joy” (Jude 24). He will “make known the riches of his glory for vessels of mercy, which he has prepared beforehand for glory” (Ro 9:23). “He calls you into his own kingdom and glory” (1 Thess 2:12). “Our blessed hope [is] the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ” (Titus 2:13).

“He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature” (Heb 1:3). “Father, I desire that they . . . may be with me where I am, to see my glory” (Jhn 17:24).

“So I exhort the elders among you, as a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, as well as a partaker in the glory that is going to be revealed” (1 Pet 5:1). “The creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption and obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God” (Ro 8:21). “We impart a secret and hidden wisdom of God, which God decreed before the ages for our glory” (1 Cor 2:7). “This light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison” (2 Cor 4:17). “Those whom he justified he also glorified” (Ro 8:30).

Eph 1:5-6 “God predestined us in love to be his sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will to the praise of the glory of his grace which he freely bestowed on us in the beloved.”
