"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life" ESV Jhn 1:14 "And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth."





Heb 1:3 "He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power"

John 15:26 "But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness about me."

Bruce Ware said: "Since the Father is really Father, as opposed to being Father nominally (in name only), and since the Father is eternal Father, then it follows that he must really have a Son, who is genuinely from Him (otherwise He isn't really Father), and that this Son from Him must likewise be eternally from Him (otherwise He isn't eternally Father)."

- (1) the Son is of the same essence as the Father (for a father begets a son like himself),
- (2) the Son is a distinct person from the Father (for the Son is begotten and the Father is unbegotten), and
- (3) there is a specific order in the relationship between Father and Son (the biblical pattern is always from the Father through the Son, as in 1 Cor. 8:6)

John 5:26

"Just as (exactly like) the Father has life in himself, so he has granted the Son also to have life in himself." Acts 13:32-34 "And we bring you the good news that what God promised to the fathers, this he has fulfilled to us their children by raising Jesus, as also it is written in the second Psalm, "You are my Son, today I have begotten you.' And as for the fact that he raised him from the dead...."

Heb 1:5 "For to which of the angels did God ever say, "You are my Son, today I have begotten you"?

V3-4 "After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs...."

Heb 5:5 "So also Christ did not exalt himself to be made a high priest, but was appointed by him who said to him, "You are my Son, today I have begotten you"

Rom 1:4 "(Jesus) was <u>declared to be</u> the Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness by his resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord"

NICENE CREED
